American Heart Association BLS CPR online Training IS REQUIRED TO BE TAKEN BEFORE ATTENDING CLASS.

CPR / First Aid may be used to count for 3 Hours of Continuing Education *only when:*

Class is taken in person. No on-line certificate / card will be accepted.

Training must include hands-on skills development through the use of mannequins or training partners.

Class is taken from an OSHA approved entity such as American Red Cross or American Heart Association.

OSHA approved American Red Cross, or American Heart Association logo is printed on card.

Card is signed and dated by the trainer.

Three (3) hours of CE credit will be given for the year when class was taken based on trainee's birthdate timeline for CE completion.

Any LTC Worker hired as of 01-07-12 or later, must take "75 Hour Long Term Care Worker Training"; made up of these four components:

Core Basic Training, Population Specific Training, Orientation Training, and Safety Training.

Core Basic Training: 40 Hours

Population Specific Training: 30 (or 32) Hours; Dementia Specialty Training (LTC Worker & Manager): 8 Hours; Mental Health Specialty Training (LTC Worker & Manager): 8 Hours; Developmental Disabilities Training - Part 1: 8 Hours; Developmental Disabilities Training - Part 2: 8 Hours; Care of the Geriatric Resident Training: 6 Hours

Courses NOT INCLUDED in the 75 Hours of LTC Worker Training; but still probable Training requirements:

Nurse Core Training: 9 Hours; Nurse Delegation; Special Focus on Diabetes Training: 3 Hours; CPR Training: 3 Hours; First Aid Training: 3 Hours;

HIV/AIDS Training (included in Core Basic Training);

Continuing Education: online only; Sometime in 2018 (hopefully). ALL C.E. offerings will be approved by DSHS.

RN's, LPN's, NA-C's and LTC Workers would still need to take Dementia Specialty Training; and / or Mental Health Specialty Training; and / or Developmental Disabilities Specialty Training, if interacting with those client categories.

NA-C's and LTC Workers would still have to take Nurse Delegation for Nursing Assistants Training if needing to be Nurse (RN) Delegated for certain tasks (including passing medications).

NA-C's and LTC Workers would also still need to take Nurse Delegation; Special Focus on Diabetes Training if needing to be Nurse (RN) Delegated to administer Insulin Injections to clients.

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
